This is a support position and reports directly to the News Director. We are looking for a talented, fast-learning, passionate person to help deliver quality local news. This is a great mid-level opportunity for self-driven professionals seeking development and on-the-ground experience.

Responsibilities can include:

- Produce, record and upload file segments to insert into NPR's Morning Edition from 8am to 9am on most weekdays and All Things Considered from 5pm to 6pm on most weekdays
- Provide local news and weather content, including spots, features, and digital stories. This will include:
 - Produce our meteorologists reports for playback on air
 - Curate stories from Northwest Public Affairs Network
 - Use local newspaper partnerships and press releases to rewrite and produce for air
- Sub for the News Director when needed
